as are therein mentioned to be made her in Testimony whereof

and desired the same to be taken and for part of his last Will  
and Testament in the presence of us the words (and by Children

**This Will** was proved at London (with the Codicil  
annexed) before the Right Honourable Sir George Lee Knight  
Doctor of Laws Master Keeper or Commissary of the Prerogative  
Court of Canterbury lawfully constituted on the tenth day of  
September in the year of Our Lord one thousand seven hundred and  
fifty three by the Oath of Margaret Walker Widow the Heiress  
of the deceased and sole executrix named in the said Will to whom  
Administration was granted of all and singular the Goods Chattels  
and Credits of the said deceased being first sworn by Commission  
Duly to administer.

John Welbank and Elizabeth Welbank Son and Daughter of my  
Cousin George Welbank late of Boroughbridge deceased ten  
Pounds a piece Item I give to Christopher Welbank and Ann  
Welbank Son and Daughter of my Cousin Christopher Welbank  
late of North Allerton deceased ten Pounds a piece Item I give  
to the Children of my Cousin Cuthbert Welbank late of North  
Allerton aforesaid deceased ten Pounds a piece Item I give to  
the Overseers of the Poor of North Cowton the Sum of five

pounds to be by them distributed to and amongst the Poor of the  
 said Township in such manner as they shall think fit All the rest  
 and residue of my Estate whatsoever and whosoever and of what  
 nature or kind soever I give devise and bequeath unto my Brother  
 George Wolbank of Grobwith in the County of Kent aforesaid &  
 his Heirs Executors Administrators and Assigns for ever And I do  
 hereby Charge all my Estate whatsoever as well Real as Personal  
 with the payment of the several Legacies and bequests before  
 mentioned all which I will and direct shall be paid within six Months  
 after my decease And I do hereby make constitute and appoint my  
 said Brother George Wolbank sole Executor of this my last Will  
 and Testament and do hereby revoke all former Wills by me made  
 and declare this to be my last Will and Testament In Witness  
 whereof I have herewith set my hand and seal this twenty eighth  
 day of November in the year of Our Lord one thousand seven hundred
